



# MHRT/C Certification Program Update



## SEASON'S GREETINGS!

It's hard to believe we are nearing the end of 2019. It's been a year of exciting changes here with full implementation of the redesigned MHRT/Community certification program. **Thank you** for your ongoing support.

Following is our version of a celebratory countdown:

- **1,510** Full certificates have been updated with an expiration date
- **515** new certificates (Full and Provisional) were issued this year
- **21** certificate holders have met the continuing education requirement and submitted renewal applications
  - **If your certificate expires in January 2020, you must get your continuing education done and submitted asap!**
- **18** academic programs and degrees from **14** different educational institutions across the state are approved to offer Full MHRT/C certification
- **18** trainers participated in the inaugural train-the-trainer to teach the non-academic curriculum for Domain 1
- All **7** remaining Domains are in varying stages of curriculum development



**Beginning January 1, 2020 ONLY** MHRT/C certificates bearing a valid expiration date will meet requirements to provide MHRT/Community services.
